The Namibia Standards Institution Certification Body is pleased to announce the introduction of new amendments to the ISO management system standards specifically targeting climate change. The purpose of the communicate is to highlight the publication of Climate Action Amendments to existing and new ISO Management Systems Standards (MSS) to reflect ISO's Climate Action commitments.

In support of the ISO London Declaration on Climate Change, ISO passed a resolution that will result in two new statements of text being added to several existing management systems standards and will be included in all new standards under development/revision, to address the need to consider the effect of Climate Change on the ability to achieve the intended results of the management system. The changes will be introduced initially as Amendments to these published standards.

The amendments are available as of 23 February 2024, you are encouraged to contact the NSI standards department to get a copy of the amendments. The amendments come at zero cost.

The Certification Body will ensure that Climate Change has been considered and if determined to be a relevant issue for its management system (ISO 9001, ISO 2200, ISO 45001 and ISO 14001), included in any objectives and mitigation activities by the organization, as required. For certified clients, the amendments will be audited during the upcoming certification activities.
