Particulars and Description of the Namibian Standards

NAMS ISO 3779: 2021 Road vehicles – Vehicle identification number (VIN) – Content and structure

This NAMS/ISO 3779 standard specifies the content and structure of a vehicle identification number (VIN) in order to establish, on a world-wide basis, a uniform identification numbering system for road vehicles.

This International Standard applies to motor vehicles, towed vehicles, motorcycles and mopeds as defined in ISO 3833.

NAMS ISO 4030: 2021 Road vehicles – Vehicle identification number (VIN) – Location and attachment

This NAMS/ISO 4030 standard specifies the requirements for the location and marking of the vehicle identification number (VIN) on motor vehicles, trailers, motorcycles and mopeds as defined in ISO 3833.

NAMS ISO 3780: 2021 Road vehicles – World manufacturer identifier (WMI) code

This NAMS/ISO 3780 standard specifies the content and structure of an identifier in order to establish, on a world-wide basis, the identification of road vehicle manufacturers. The world manufacturer identifier (WMI) constitutes the first section of the vehicle identification number (VIN) described in ISO 3779.

This International Standard applies to motor vehicles, towed vehicles, motorcycles and mopeds as defined in ISO 3833.
